Speakeasy Solutions Google Chrome Commands

Please find following a list of commands for Google Chrome, to be used in conjunction with the SeS Google Chrome Voice Command. These commands are designed for a more hands-free experience with Google Chrome as well as to improve efficiencies.

Introduction

Full text control is not currently available in Google Chrome. You may opt to use Dragon's Dictation Box, or you may dictate directly into Google Chrome's text fields with an understanding of the limitations of not having full text control.

Google Chrome provides two types of dialogue boxes – those styled in accordance with standard Windows API coding, and dialogue boxes that are quite dissimilar from the standard Windows dialogue boxes. While you can use Dragon to click on dialogue box options by voice for Windows compatible dialogue boxes, you will be unable to click on the options and buttons found on Google Chrome's non-standard Windows dialogue boxes by voice.

You will be assisted greatly by understanding how to operate your computer completely hands-free with Dragon's various voice commands that emulate keystrokes and mouse clicks. Please contact Speakeasy Solutions if you wish specific training in this regard.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ previous ▪ next 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ page 	Loads the previous or next page from the browsing history.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ open wrench menu 	Opens the wrench menu.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ toggle bookmarks 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ open <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ history ▪ downloads ▪ task manager 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ browser toolbar 	Places focus on the first tool in the browser toolbar. Use typical keyboard shortcuts (i.e. <Tab>, <End>, <Left> keys etc.) for moving between the items. The <Esc> key returns focus from the toolbar back to the page.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ context menu 	Activates the context menu of the item or tool selected in the browser toolbar (per above).
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ next pane 	Switches focus to the next keyboard accessible pane such as address bar, bookmarks bar, web content and downloads bar.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ open <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ developer tools ▪ browsing data ▪ help centre

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ print ▪ save ▪ reload 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ page
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ stop loading ▪ find on page 	Once the find dialogue box is activated, you must hand type what you are searching for, or use the command "press (key(s))".
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ next ▪ previous 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ match Finds the next and previous match of the text from the find dialogue box.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ reload ignore cache 	Reloads the current page, ignoring the cached content.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ bookmark 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ page ▪ all pages
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ toggle fullscreen 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ zoom 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ in ▪ out ▪ normal
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ scroll down 	Scrolls down the webpage.

Address Bar

Command	Description
▪ go to address	Places the cursor focus inside the address bar, highlighting any URL that is there as well.
▪ go there	Opens the URL in a new tab.

Menus

Command	Description
▪ tools ▪ bookmarks	Activate these menus.
▪ menu	
▪ create application shortcuts	
▪ open extensions	
▪ report an issue	
▪ import bookmarks
